Booster Groups	Booster classes in English and Mathematics for pupils in Year 6.
Wrap Around Care	To support pupils families at the beginning and end of the school day.
Curriculum Enrichment Clubs	To ensure all children are given the opportunities to engage in challenging and new experiences.
School journey	To enable all children to experience and participate in residential trips.
CPD /Resources	In house training for staff working with LAC / Adopted children. Resources to support particular learning
