

## PE and Sport Premium Spending at Sheringdale

Updated Nov 2019

Each year we publish a report outlining the ways in which we spent last year's government PE and Sport funding, how we plan to spend this year's allocation and how it benefits the pupils at Sheringdale.

### Impact

- Increased PE participation including after school clubs
- 86% of Year 6 children and 66% of Year 5 children participated in school, local or regional PE events or competitions.
- We entered 19 competitions in eight different sports throughout the year reaching the finals of the London Youth in Tag Rugby
- Improved PE equipment and facilities
- A very high standard of PE teaching within the schools as recognised by OFSTED and the LA Inspector.
- Achieved Healthy Schools London (HSL) Silver, November 2017.

- Aiming to complete HSL Gold in Academic year 2019/20
- Maintained School Games Silver Award in July 2019.
- Both year 3 classes swam for a term during the year. Each week they received an hour's lesson from a qualified Swim England Coach.
- By the end of the year, 69% of children could perform front crawl to a good standard and 27% could swim a length of 25m unaided.
- Several children who had never been swimming before were able to put their faces in the water and enjoy moving about in the shallow end and practising front crawl.
- 73% of 2019 Year 6 could swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres.
- 39% of 2018 Year 6 could use a range of strokes effectively [front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke].

## **Sheringdale Primary School Sports Report**

At Sheringdale Primary School we aim to provide high quality physical activity during the school day as well as extra-curricular opportunities. Physical Education develops pupils' physical competence and confidence as well as their ability to develop these skills to perform a range of activities. For children between the ages of four and eleven it is vital that P.E. is taught regularly and to a high standard.

The school currently provides a minimum of 2 hours of P.E. every week for children in KS1 and KS2 which is often boosted by the large amount of extra-curricular activities that are on offer throughout the year. The school has allocated 70% of a PE specialist teacher's time, to deliver PE lessons throughout KS1 and KS2. This is now supplemented by two HLTA PE specialists who also teach throughout the school.

Each summer we celebrate with school Sports Day where every child takes part in a variety of track and field events and has the chance to compete and to win. We have done this for the last six years, the feedback is fantastic and we try to improve what we offer year on year.

In 2018-19, we had a large number of children participating across a range of competitive sports including; Athletics, Tag Rugby, Cricket, Cross Country, Football, Hockey, Netball and Rounders.

All these competitions are run by a number of providers. The Wandsworth School Games Association, organised the Tag Rugby tournament in the Autumn where our team won the and went on to represent the borough at the London Youth Games against 31 other teams from all around London. They battled through the groups stages and then the knockout stages to finish in the top half of the competition.

Other tournaments are run the Putney Primary Schools Sports Association (PPSSA) which has 16 member schools. This is a teacher-run organisation that arranges competitions in several sports throughout the year. They are very popular and well supported by children, staff and parents.

Additionally, we have always enjoyed close sporting links with our neighbouring schools have arranged friendlies in various sports with Riversdale, St Michaels and Swaffield Schools.

We are also continually promoting links with the wider sporting community so that children can further develop their interests and access the best opportunities around. Each year we receive coaching from the Wimbledon Junior Tennis Initiative and have good links with All Stars tennis in King Georges Park, AFC Wimbledon and Spencer Cricket Club.

Finally, each term our equipment is assessed and new stock is brought to renew and replace it. We feel it is important that a substantial part of the budget is allocated towards this.
