Provision/ Spending	Objectives
<b>In class support/ Interventions</b>	Teaching staff to support Pupil Premium children, with a focus on English and Mathematics. Teaching Assistants to support English and Mathematics interventions DHT, SENCo and TA's to support children with social, emotional and behavioural issues – e.g. ELSA groups.
<b>Booster Groups</b>	Booster classes in English and Mathematics for pupils in Year 6.
<b>Wrap Around Care</b>	To support pupils families at the beginning and end of the school day.
<b>Curriculum Enrichment Clubs</b>	To ensure all children are given the opportunities to engage in challenging and new experiences.
<b>School journey</b>	To enable all children to experience and participate in residential trips.
<b>CPD /Resources</b>	In house training for staff working with Pupil Premium children. Resources to support particular learning needs.
<b>Daily Milk /School Meals</b>	Provide a healthy nutritious meals
