Teaching Assistants to support English and Mathematics interventions DHT/AHT, SENCo and TA's to support children with social, emotional and behavioural issues – e.g. ELSA groups.
Booster Groups	Booster classes in English and Mathematics for pupils in Year 6.
Wrap Around Care	To support pupils families at the beginning and end of the school day.
Curriculum Enrichment Clubs	To ensure all children are given the opportunities to engage in challenging and new experiences.
School journey	To enable all children to experience and participate in residential trips.
CPD /Resources	In house training for staff working with Pupil Premium children. Resources to support particular learning needs.
Daily Milk /School Meals	Provide a healthy nutritious meals

2020-21 Pupil Premium Results

These results are based on teacher assessments at the end of the academic year 2020-21. During the third lockdown on 4th January 2021 all pupil premium children were encouraged to attend school and those who did not, were offered Google Chromebooks to support their remote learning.
