This week we have been...

- Starting a new story called 'Bedtime for Monsters' by Ed Vere - we looked at the first two pages which ask 'Do you ever wonder if somewhere, not too far away, there *might* be...MONSTERS?'
 - Painting our own monsters.
 - Looking at maps of the different places the monster travelled.
 - Making our own monsters out of playdough and recycled modelling.
 - Singing lots of songs.
 - Ordering and recognising Numicon shapes, counting 1:1 to 10, and representing numbers on our fingers.
 - Using the calendar every day, singing the days of the week, months of the year, talking about the date, weather and season.
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Next week we will...

- Continue to look at the 'Bedtime for Monsters' story.
 - Make festive/winter decorations.
 - Continue to create rhythms and sequences with percussive instruments and body percussion.
 - Continue counting using Numicon and recap some shape names.
 - Practice the songs we already know.
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To help at home you could...

- Practice hearing the sounds at the beginning of words. We do this daily, particularly with days of the week and months of the year, but a really good way to try it out is playing 'I Spy' but with phonic sounds rather than letters.
