- Reading a new story called 'How to Find a Fruit Bat' by Michelle Robinson.
- Practising with the 'Rainbow Robot' to segment words into their sounds by 'chopping' the word with our Rainbow Robot arms.
- Comparing groups of objects, estimating which group has more/less, and counting to make sure.
- Continuing adding and subtracting low numbers.
