This week we have been...

- Retelling the story 'Handa's Surprise' and introducing the story of 'Handa's Hen'
- Continued to look at and taste various fruits —this week we have tried mango, melon, nectarine, papaya and grapes.
- Making our own tally charts of their favourite fruits—and looking at what fruits are most popular and least popular.
- Comparing groups of objects, estimating which group has more/less, and counting to make sure.
- Continued to work on adding and taking away numbers below 10
- Using different coloured paints the children have been printing with different types of fruit.

Next week we will be...

- Continuing to look at the stories of 'Handa's Surprise', 'Handa's Hen' and 'Handa's Noisy Night'. Retelling the different stories in their own words.
- Learning about Sheilah Sheldone, a young Kenyan artist, and particularly her paintings of colourful lions.
- Continuing to compare groups of objects, estimating which group has more/less, and counting to make sure.
- Continuing to work on adding and taking away numbers below 10.
- Visiting Littlehampton on Tuesday 21st June—don't forget sunhats and sun cream! It may also be useful to put a pair of leggings/ trousers into their bags, as last year it was a little windy and some of the children got cold legs.

To help at home you could...

- Encourage the children to add together two groups of objects less than 10 and talk about 'more' or 'less'.
