


Weekly Message

It has been another brilliant week and the children are doing a great job with their new reading books! They have been doing group reading with their teachers and now can blends sounds together.

We have been reading the book 'The Disgusting Sandwich' and the children have been thinking about what they would put in their own disgusting sandwich. They were extremely creative with their ideas — even coming up with ideas like rainbow-coloured snail slime.

In Maths, we have been busy working on our formation of numbers up to 5. They are beginning to use five-frames effectively to help them with their counting.
