It has been a fantastic week in reception! The children have become a lot more confident in blending their sounds together and are continuing to learn new sounds too!

We have been learning about what foods are healthy and unhealthy for our bodies and what happens if we eat too many unhealthy foods. We have also written about what our favourite foods are using our phonics.

In Maths, we are continuing to represent numbers up to 5 using a variety of concrete and pictorial methods. We have been practising subitising to instantly recognise the number of objects without needing to count them!



A Peek at the Week

Next week, we will be looking at the topic of Autumn. We will be looking at the changes of seasons and what is special about this time of year! We will go on a lovely Autumn walk and observe the changes.

In Maths, we will continue to practise our number formation and to compare groups of objects.

Phonics

This week we have learnt the /m/, /d/, /g/, /o/, and /u/ sound. Please keep practising the sounds and letter formation using the songs and sheets we have sent home. We'll continue to send these home daily. Thank you for all your hard work at home!
