Good afternoon parents and caregivers! We hope you had a lovely weekend.




Today at Nursery we spoke about Diwali and enjoyed hearing about some of the children's celebrations. To celebrate the children made salt dough candle holders which we will be decorating tomorrow. Students will also be able to design a Rangoli using coloured rice. We continued our conversations about Remembrance day and we hope you liked the sneak peak of their Poppy's in the window! Later in the week will begin a new story 'Anna Hibiscus' Song'. In reading sessions we have been pointing out the title, author and blurb, making predictions and retelling the story after. Children will also be encouraged to share what makes them feel happy and who is in their family as these are themes of the book.




We continue to do the calendar each morning, singing the days of the week, months of the year, seasons and weather songs. Lots of singing is happening this week as we will continue practicing 'Follow the Star' and learning 'Twinkl Twinkl Little Star' and 'Jingle Bells'. Children have been comparing different sound makers and identifying loud and quiet sounds.




In numeracy, we will continue to sing our number songs, counting 1:1 to 10 and representing the numbers on our fingers. We are learning to write the number 4 which they are already did an amazing job of today! Children will have the opportunity to make different shapes using peg boards and playdough.



Thank you for your support with encouraging the children to come in on their own in the mornings. This is working fantastically so far and we'd like to continue, however, If your child is still finding it a bit tricky, please don't worry—we'll get there in the end!
