Welcome to Week 6!

This week:

- We have been reading 'It's not Just a Blanket' by Annaliese Stoney and playing a game called 'this is a box' to inspire our junk modelling. This morning a mystery letter was found in the classroom from an Elf! The Elf has asked us to build a home for him using junk modelling so that he will have somewhere nice to stay in the nursery.
- We continue to sing our number songs, counting 1:1 to 10 and representing the numbers on our fingers.
- We are learning to write the number seven using a number rhyme.
- We are building 'numicon cities' and 'counting towers'. Children are being encouraged to count as they play.
- We do the calendar each morning, singing the days of the week, months of the year, seasons and weather songs.
- We are still learning the songs for our Christmas performance. We have taught the children actions and usually listen to the songs on a school program called sing up, however I have provided YouTube links with the lyrics below so you can continue practicing at home.
