Spring 1 Week 4



Last week we:

- Did the calendar each morning, singing the days of the week, months of the year, seasons and weather songs.
- Read the story 'Emily Brown and the Thing' and discussed things that help us to go to sleep and why sleep is important.
- Painted a sky background and coloured in our own thing which we glued onto our painting. We hope you like seeing them in the window.
- Continued to sing our number songs, counting 1:1 to 10 and representing the numbers on our fingers.
- Practiced counting using 1:1 correspondence to make the characters from number blocks.
- Continued fine motor activities such as play dough and peg boards.




This week:

- We are reading 'Astro Girl' by Ken Wilson-Max.
- The theme will be space and students will learn new topic specific vocabulary. Today we discussed what we already know about space and we were very impressed by the children's knowledge! We also discussed what they would like to learn about space and some of the questions included: what do the different planets look like and what do astronauts wear?
- We will make rockets using a range of shapes and write our numbers on them.
- We are painting moons and stars.
- The children will be baking planet cookies.
- We will be discussing what we would like to be when we grow up.



Extra messages:

- Don't forget to wear trainers on Tuesday for PE in the afternoon and Friday for morning PE.
- If you have any space themed books at home we would love to read them at school! These could also be non-fiction texts.
- More flour donations would be much appreciated for playdough and baking! Thank you!
