


Our vision and values

- Our Early Years philosophy is:




EYFS Areas

EYFS Curriculum

- **Characteristics of Effective Learning** – these refer to processes rather than outcomes
- Playing and exploring – children investigate and experience things, and ‘have a go’
- Active learning – children concentrate and keep on trying if they encounter difficulties, and enjoy achievements
- Creating and thinking critically – children have and develop their own ideas, make links between ideas, and develop strategies for doing things



Reception

- Two Reception classes (Ladybird Class & Butterfly Class)
- 30 children in each
- 1 class teacher & 1 Teaching Assistant in each class
- Adjoining rooms with large outdoor provision and sheltered classroom extension
- Mud Kitchen
- Climbing & outdoor building equipment
